Membership Nomination Forms

One of these forms is to be used for a person seeking membership in the Rotary Club of Ann Arbor. The contents of the form will be evaluated by the Membership Committee with a recommendation made to the Board of Directors at its next scheduled meeting (nominally the third Wednesday of the month).

There are two versions: one for candidates new to Rotary and the other for transferring, reinstating or former Rotarians.

For candidates new to Rotary, approval by the Board awards the person with “Member-elect” status. As such, the person is given a badge with a blue ribbon and invited to participate fully in all Club meetings, events and activities in advance of the formal induction of his or her class, usually in March and October. Upon induction, the candidate will pay an initiation fee and begin to pay dues and the Community Service Assessment on a pro-rated basis and will be entered into the Rotary and Club rosters.

The process is essentially the same for persons who have been Rotarians or are seeking to transfer their Active membership from another Rotary club. The difference is that such persons are eligible for full membership in our club immediately upon Board approval and are exempt from the initiation fee. In order to facilitate their entry or re-entry, the person will be invited to be part of the orientation session for the upcoming class of new members.
