1,008 CHILDREN SEEN

In 2025, we saw a record number of children through our follow-up program. We even did a small renovation project to be able to serve and host more families on follow-up days!

2,000+ MEALS SERVED

A hot meal is served to every individual that comes for a follow-up appointment. The children being seen are also given a small glass of milk to enjoy with their plate of food. An additional resource used is Plumpy doz, a supplement designed to prevent malnutrition. This is prescribed to approximately 50% of the most at-risk children in the program.



700+ ANTIBIOTICS

Approximately 50% of children seen each month require an antibiotic for various infections. We are grateful to have the resources to provide these essential medications.



FOOD & HYGIENE KITS

When a child graduates from our inpatient program, we provide them with a kit of food and hygiene products. This kit provides them with essential resources as they make their transition back to their homes. With the grate, we distributed 83 hygiene kits. At follow-up appointments, we continue to distribute manna packs (a dried, scientifically formulated, nutrient-dense meal packet designed to combat malnutrition)

In 2025, we distributed more than 15,000 packs!



TRANSPORTATION & COMMUNICATIONS

Built into our follow-up program budget is also funding to provide families with cash to pay for their transportation home after inpatient graduation. We've also budgeted for phone & internet expenses as we arrange appointments, consult with medical staff by phone, and communicate with community advocates. These expenses may seem insignificant, but it's an essential resource in our holistic approach to ensuring children have a lasting recovery from malnutrition.
